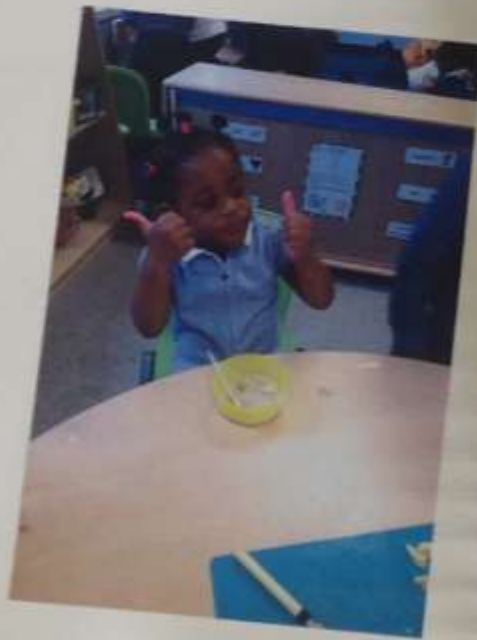

"This is so much fun!" Maddox



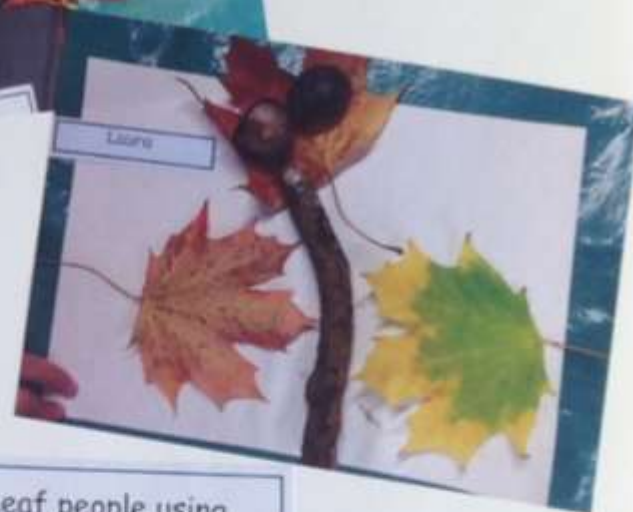
We looked closely and used our senses to explore the treasures.

We've been learning about patterns.



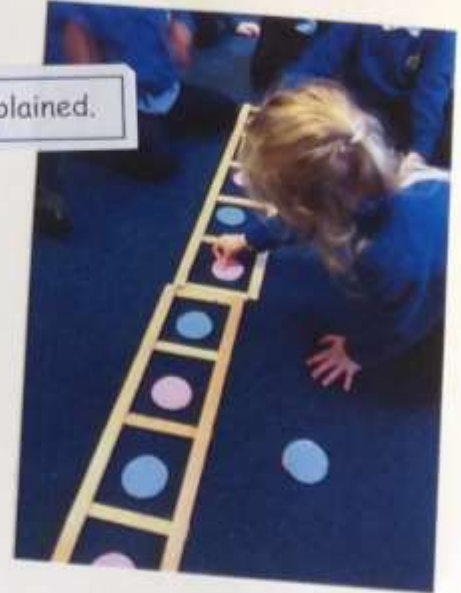
We continued patterns, created patterns and corrected mistakes in patterns.

We thought perhaps the bear had left the sled in our classroom by mistake.

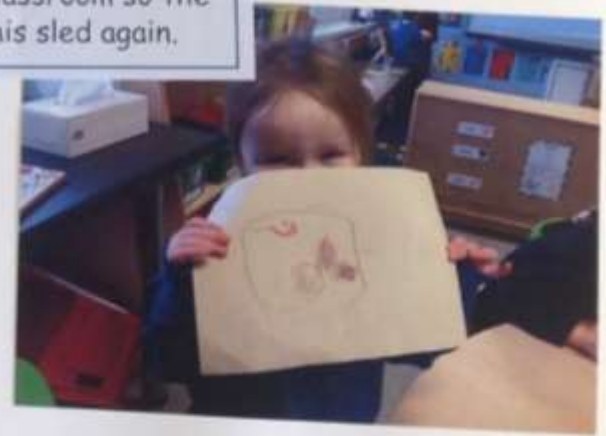




We made some footprints in the play dough.
