

Dear Parents/Carers

I am sending this to all parents so that there is transparency and that everybody is informed directly.

Firstly may I say that the last couple of months have been the hardest weeks of my career as teacher never mind Head Teacher. Being in school with so few children and staff - it really hasn't felt like our school at all. This is why when I hear from our teachers of the work the children have posted on line or sent into school; it reminds me to stay positive. The teachers tell me that every week they have posted lots of tasks and every week our children are completing them.

I am so proud of our children in trying their hardest in continue with their learning which has looked so differently hasn't it? To all parents, may I say that you have had the most taxing, frustrating and anxious time of all. Not only have you kept your families safe and do what all parents do but you have held down your working commitments whilst timetabling your children's learning in a positive manner and in such difficult circumstances.- You are awesome!

I do hope that very soon I can welcome all our children back but of course in the safest possible way.

Having safety for all at the forefront of our plan to return we have devised the following timetable.

Key Worker children - On Monday the 8th of June all key worker children plus other key children will return to school at 8:45 - 3:15 Please understand that it is imperative that you are on time and do not arrive too early. If you return to work in the coming weeks and are a key worker please contact me.

Year 6 - Also on the 8th of June and every day after that; all the year 6 children whose parents have contacted school about their return will arrive at school no earlier than 9:25 to enter the school grounds at 9:30 and will leave at 2:30 - **if you have not said that your child is returning please do not just arrive at school on the 8th June. You must contact school and you will be instructed as to if and when your child may now return.**

Year 1 - Again on the 8th of June and every day after that will all the year 1 children whose parents have contacted school about their return will arrive at school no earlier than **9:10** to enter school at **9:15** and will leave at **2:30** - **if you have not said that your child is returning please do not just arrive at school on the 8th June. You must contact school and you will be instructed as to if and when your child may now return.**

Year Reception - On Thursday 11th June and every day after that will all the reception children whose parents have contacted school about their return will arrive at school no earlier than **8:55** to enter school at 9am and will leave at **2:15** - **If you have not said that your child is returning, please do not just arrive at school on the 11th June. You must contact school and you will be instructed as to if and when your child may now return.**

Year Nursery - On Monday 15th June and every day after that the nursery children whose parents have contacted school about their return will do so however this will be on a part time basis until such time that school can extend the day further. **School will be intouch as to the start and finish times for your child. If you have not said that your child is returning please do not just arrive at school on the 15th June. You must contact school and you will be instructed as to if and when your child may now return.**

If capacity and safety allows, we will begin to introduce other year groups from the 22nd of June beginning with year 5

- Please note that I will write to individual cohorts outlining all the safety measures in place - what school will do regarding health and wellbeing health and safety and curriculum - what will be expected of parents and children. Also the continued support for the children who are sheilding and who will be continuing their learning at home.
