Following the official announcement from the Government regarding the tentative plans to re-open primary schools, I would like to reassure you that our priority remains the same - to keep our children, families and staff safe. This will continue to be our ultimate priority going forward.

We have already been planning for how a phased return may look, and will continue to follow the very latest guidance, as it is released. As soon as is possible, we will share any plans we have with you and address any questions you may have.

I would particularly like to assure you that I fully understand the responsibility we have to our children and community to make the right choices for the safety of everyone. It is crucial we get this right, so planning will be meticulous.

Currently, we have no firm details other than the *possibility* of Year 6, Year 1 and Reception. Speculation and media hype on how this will look isn't helpful. When the time comes, we will be ready to open in the safest way possible, and you will be fully informed.

In the meantime, we remain open for key worker and vulnerable children *however, if a child can be safely cared for at home, then they should stay at home.*

We will continue to provide online and printed sheets to support the children's learning at home.
